Stravinsky and Ravel

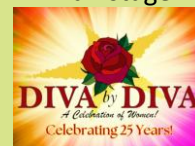
Friday, March 14th 2025 10:30 am

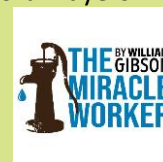

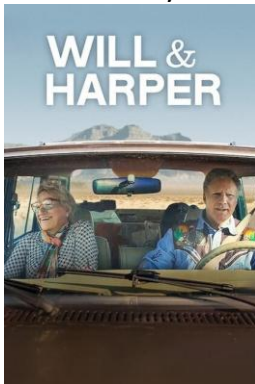
